The program offers opportunities to explore all aspects of an elementary classroom, while teaching under the mentorship of a lead teacher.

In addition to placement in a nursery through grade 3 classroom, co-teachers gain broad professional experience working with multiple age groups as responsibilities include coaching athletic teams in grades 6–9 or teaching in the after-school enrichment program for grades 1–3.
