How to access your classes in OAKS

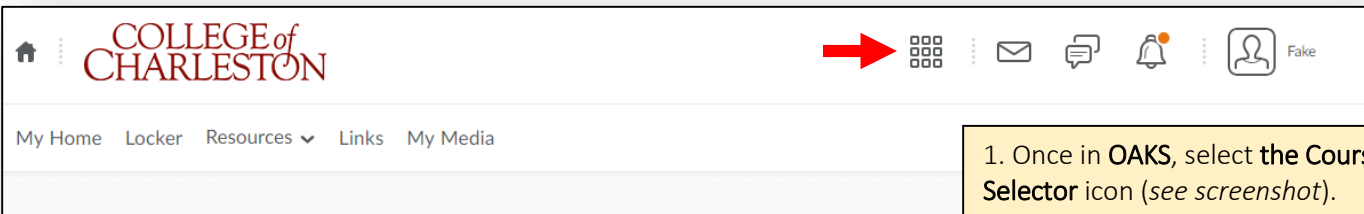
Note: OAKS is the College's learning management system, based on the Desire2Learn platform. Students can access their course materials through OAKS, participate in class discussions, complete assignments and quizzes and etc.

If you have taken less than 12 courses, all of your courses will appear in the **Course Selector** (see screenshot 2). If you have taken twelve or more classes at the College of Charleston, you will have to pin courses to the **My Courses** area on your **My Home** page in order to see your current courses (see guide on how to pin courses to the *My Courses* area on the *My Home* page).

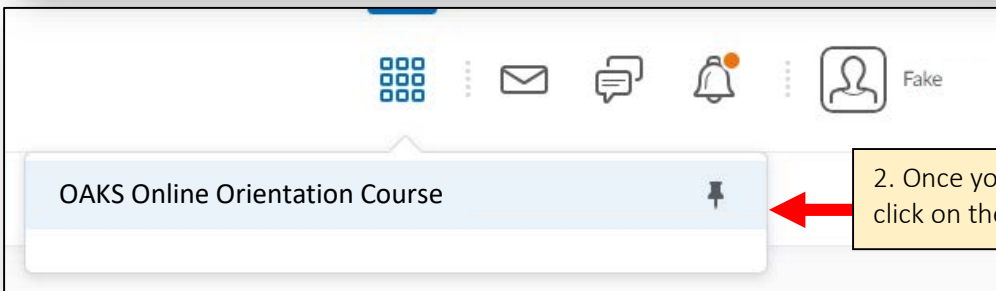
Accessing your Course(s):

In the examples listed below, you will see only one course listed. If you have multiple courses, they will show up in the

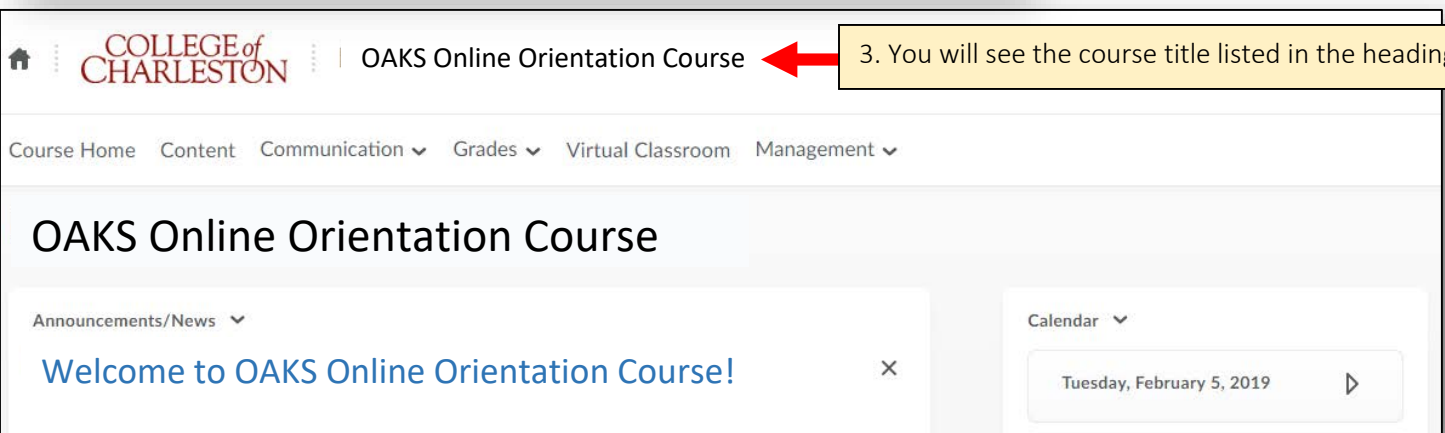
 **Course Selector** in OAKS.
