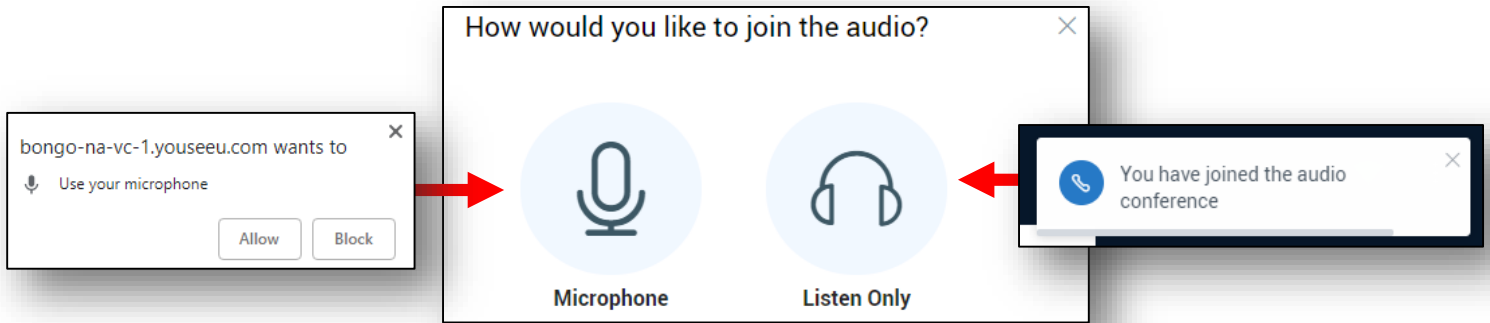

3. The **Meeting Lobby Page** will appear. Read all of the content then click **Enter Meeting Room** (displays the moderator, start time, quick tips, recommended browsers, and session management)

4. A pop-up screen will appear, select one of the options asking, “How would you like to join the audio?” **Microphone** or **Listen Only**.

Note: If you select **Microphone** option, you will get a pop-up window requesting that you **Allow** or **Block**. Select **Allow**



5. Once the session open, you will have the options to see chat, users, messages, video, download speeds, settings, leaving a session, etc. (see screenshot(s)).
