Self and Society

Culture and Diversity

- Exhibit more interest in human diversity (cultural, ethnic, and racial identity) and greater familiarity with relevant language, traditions, and other practices.

Social Roles and Occupations

- Exhibit more sophisticated understanding of a broader variety of adult roles and occupations.

Civics

Skills for Democratic Participation

- Participate in group activities, understanding the importance of respecting others' opinions, group decision making, and respect for majority rules.

Conflict Resolution

- Capable of negotiating, compromising, and finding cooperative means of resolving conflict with peers or adults.

History

Understanding Past Events

- Demonstrate an understanding of the relationship between events and experiences, both past and present.

Anticipating and Planning Future Events

- Distinguish when future events will happen, plan for them, and make choices that anticipate future needs.

Geography and Ecology

Navigating Familiar Locations

- Identify the physical characteristics of familiar locations, such as home, school, community and region (e.g., landforms, weather).

Caring for the Natural World

- Show an interest in nature and in caring for the natural world (e.g., recycling, cleaning up trash).

Understand the Physical World Through Drawing and Maps

- Use and create drawings, maps, and models to represent the physical world.

- Understand ownership and what stores do.
- Show an interest in money and its function.
