Volunteer Opportunities at Elitha Donner Elementary School

Classroom Volunteers

Work regularly with classroom teachers. They assist students and help with projects and field trips. *Time commitment: during the school day, average of one hour per week.*

VIP Event Coordinator

Meet with Administration to discuss the event, plan activities, coordinate volunteers, to come together in a smooth concerted manner. Duties may include heading a committee responsible for soliciting businesses and individuals for item or service donations, arranging food and entertainment, decorating and in many other capacities. *Time commitment: May be done during or after the school day*

Supporting School Events

Provide assistance to the VIP Event Coordinator and/or Administration. Volunteer to provide support prior to the event; assist with preparations the day of the event, decorating, setting up, etc. Opportunities include: Back-to-School Night, PTA movie nights, Open House. *Time commitment: Depend on activity, usually short-term and fun. May be done after the school day.*

Special Interest

Work to bridge school with the community and local businesses, special are of interest to share with kids; student finance, gardening, advertising, sports. *Time commitment: depends on the activity, usually short-term and fun. May be done during or after the school day.*

Special Activity Volunteers

Assist Administration with a specific project at school. Projects may include: Science Fair, Spelling Bee, Writing Contest, Student competitions, Talent Show, Student Store, Book Fair and National Elementary Honor Society. *Time commitment: Depends on activity, usually short-term and fun.*

Volunteer Tutors

Give students extra help with academic subjects. *Time commitment: During the school day, average of one hour per week.*

School Communications

Work to improve communication between the school and parents. Duties include: sending out e-mails, painting posters, telephone trees, etc. *Time commitment: May be done during or after the school day depending on medium used for communication.*
