Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wear headphones, when possible ● Try to find an area with limited distractions during school time ● Enter Zoom with microphone off ● Be aware of your surroundings and what is being shared with your class ● Take good care of your borrowed devices so they can be returned in their original condition 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Wear school-appropriate clothing ● Eat/drink during the breaks ● Use school-appropriate language ● Use kind words ● Listen to and track the speaker ● Use the mute button ● Only use the chat feature, when enabled, for on-task conversations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Check your Classroom stream ● All comments should be helpful, on-topic, and appropriate ● Learn and use your teacher's preferred method of communication (email, Synergy, Class Dojo, etc.)
Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Log in on time ● Use district-issued devices for class/school work only ● Have supplies ready or near your workspace ● Keep a clean and organized workspace ● Turn off other devices in the background (phones, tv, music, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stay engaged throughout the session ● Stay off unassigned sites and other devices (games, phones, tv, music, etc.) ● Remain in established, appropriate workspace ● Actively participate in learning tasks and discussions ● Follow directions ● Notify the teacher of mistakes, errors, or broken links 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Communicate immediately with teacher if there are issues with assignments ● Participate in teacher office-hour, if available ● Turn in assignments on time and in the correct place ● Turn off all non-academic devices
Persevere	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Set goals ● Maintain an agenda/calendar ● Be resourceful ● If unable to login, or experiencing other technical difficulties, try again! If, after a few attempts, you continue to have challenges, connect with your teacher. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ask on-topic questions (raise hand, chat box, etc.) ● Be patient ● Be understanding; know that we are all learning together ● Remain in the frame ● Try new activities and take risks ● Don't give up; ask for help 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Problem solve ● Focus on learning during school hours ● Connect with your teacher when assistance is needed
