Character Education Corner:

Our character trait this next two months in Curiosity. Albert Einstein said "I have no special talent. I am only passionately curious." Why does this matter for our kids? When kids are curious about something, they want to learn how and why something works. In math for example, students who are curious are likely to understand materials at a conceptual level, not only a procedural level. This allows for deeper understanding of the material. Talk to your children about ways that they practice curiosity. Ask them "when was the last time you heard something that peaked your interest?" Lastly, make sure to model curiosity at home. Students need to hear adult saying "I don't know this yet? But let me find out". These days new information comes at us all the time, let's share it with our kids and peek their curiosity about the world.


