Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI)

This is a reading comprehension test students take. The computer scores the test giving students a lexile number. There is a range of lexile numbers where students should be for each grade (numbered) level.

The lexile level is also color coordinated, thus when students check books out of the library they can look for books in their reading level.

Students take the SRI test three times a year during Computer Class.

Scholastic Reading Counts (RC) or (SRC)

This is a program that levels books appropriate for student reading levels. When students check books out from our library they can look for the appropriate colored label to know the book is a “good” one for them to read. Not too hard or not too easy. After reading the book students can go to a school computer and take a Reading Counts Quiz on that book.

Most books are a part of this Reading Counts Program, but not all the Reading Counts Books have that special label.

Taking a Reading Counts Quiz:

Using the computers students can take a Reading Counts Quiz to determine their level of comprehension. Quizzes are 10 multiple choice questions and students must pass with 70% correct or better. For each quiz that students pass they earn points. The number of points earned depends on how hard the book was to read and understand. The harder the book the more points the student can earn.

If students pass the RC test they can earn points. If they pass the quiz computer will automatically keep track of their points earned. Our school has certificates and prizes for those who earn enough points.

If they do not pass, students should choose the “Review Wrong Answers” option in the computer. They will be shown the question they missed and the wrong answers they choose. Then when rereading the book they can look for the questions they missed. Then after reading the book, students can retake the test for a total of three tries. They must wait 24 hours before retaking the quiz.

Reading Counts Quiz Award Scale

Every 25 points students will get to choose an item from the treasure chest in the library. Just tell Mrs. Gomes when you’ve reached a goal. In addition these awards will be given at the Awards Assemblies.

25 points – Ribbon, certificate, Bookmarker

50 points – Ribbon, certificate, Pencil

100 points – Ribbon, certificate, Eraser

250 points – Ribbon, certificate, Reader Dog Tag/Key Chain

500 points – Ribbon, certificate, Charm for Dog Tag

Each additional 100 points- another Charm for Dog Tag

Top student from 6th Grade class or whole school at the end of the year will get a Reading Award Medallion!
