Welcome to the 2017-2018 School Year!

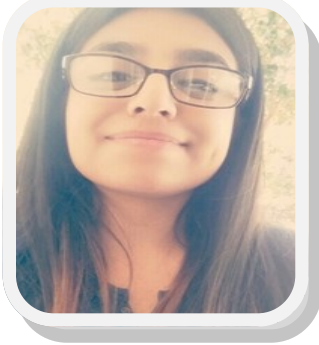

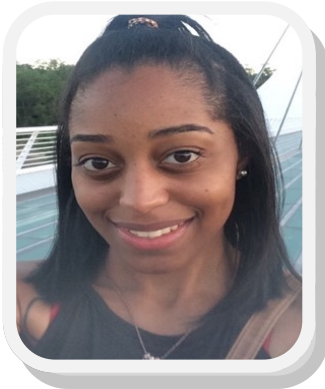

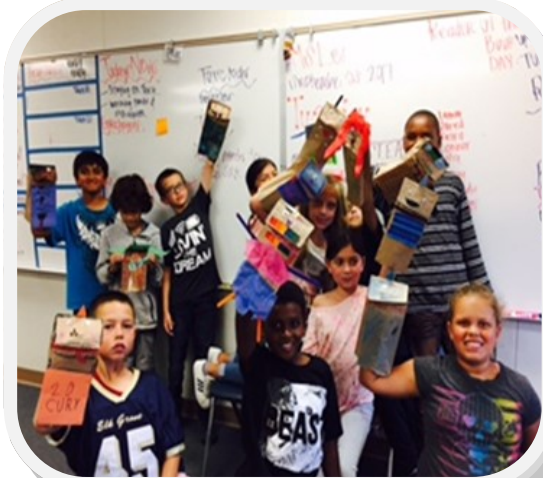
Mr. Wilson
