



Elk Grove Elementary School Dress Code

School attire is expected to reflect children's mental and physical preparedness for the business of learning. When students are not dressed appropriately for school, the parent will be notified and may be asked to bring a change of clothing. Appropriateness of new fashions will be reviewed by school administration.

General Information	All clothing items and accessories cannot be disrespectful in nature for they disrupt the school environment. They may not contain vulgar, derogatory, discriminatory, or suggestive language or diagrams. This includes pictures, slogans, and words promoting violence or drugs/alcohol, and are racially, ethnically, or sexually offensive.
Pants, Skirts, Shorts, and Skorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pants and shorts should be worn at or above the waist (no sagging) with undergarments completely hidden.• Pants, skirts, and dresses should not drag on the ground.• Dresses, skirts, shorts, and skorts should be no shorter than mid-thigh.
Sleepwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No pajamas or sleepwear is allowed except on Spirit Days.
Tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tops should be appropriately fitted well, covering the midriff and cleavage area.• Straps on tops must be at least two finger-widths (adult) wide.• Halter tops, tops with spaghetti straps, or open backed dresses and tops are not allowed unless a shirt, jacket, or shrug is worn over it at all times. Bra straps need to be covered at all times.• See-through or fish-net fabrics, off the shoulder or low-cut tops, short/crop tops, or tube tops are not permitted.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safe shoes with back heel straps must be worn at all times.• Closed-toed shoes should be worn on physical education days to allow students to fully participate in this program.• No Heelys or skate shoes (tennis shoes with detachable wheels), bare feet, flip-flops, shower shoes, bedroom slippers, stocking feet, socks only, cleats/spikes, and high heels or wedges (unless medically necessary) are allowed.
Accessories: Hats, Hoods, Head Coverings, Jewelry, and Makeup	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hats, with the bill forward, and hoods may be worn outdoors only during appropriate weather conditions.• Head coverings for religious or cultural reasons are permitted.• Bandanas are not allowed except on Spirit Days.• Students may wear watches, earrings, and necklaces that surround the neckline. Earring studs are preferred for safety reasons. Long chains and necklaces are not allowed.• No makeup is allowed. Clear, lip balm is permissible.
