



Student Pledge for *#UnfollowBullying* Campaign

Draw a Line - Delete negative or hateful comments rather than giving the bully an audience.

Speak Up - If you know the person doing the cyberbullying, and feel comfortable, talk to him/her. Help them to understand the harm they are doing. Or if you are being cyberbullied, find someone you trust to confide in. Speak up for yourself and for others; don't let fear silence you.

Consider Others - When online, ask yourself are you sending something you would say face-to-face? If not, don't send it.

Help transform the *#UnfollowBullying* campaign at your site from a vision to a reality by taking this pledge:

1. I agree to step up and take a stand against cyberbullying
2. I agree to use technology for good and not as a tool to hurt and harm others
3. I agree to support others who are targets of cyberbullying

6. I agree to respect others by not posting/tagging embarrassing or inappropriate pictures or videos of anyone

10. I agree to "unfollow," "unfriend," and delete cyberbullying
