Attack on the Alamo

1. A silent charge on the North wall (sentries killed in their sleep)
2. The Mexicans yelled battle cries and the cannons opened fire taking down dozens of Mexican soldiers
3. Mexican reinforcements started an attack on the West wall
4. North and Southeast walls breached and the Southeast cannon was captured
5. The Texans retreated into the chapel and were eventually subdued, captured, and executed

Interesting Facts About the Alamo

- The siege began on Feb. 23, 1836 and ended Mar. 6, 1836
- The youngest to die was 15
- There were 18 cannons(one 18 lb, one 16 lb, one 12 lb, one 9" Pedro, two 8 lbs, six 6 lbs, four 4 lbs, and two 3lbs)
- The floor is 2' taller than in 1836
- A chunk of the wall was built into the Chicago Tribune Tower
- The Alamo was defended against orders
- Only about 200 men defended the Alamo
