Apprehension	<i>Noun</i>	A fearful feeling about the future; dread	She felt dread and apprehension about the upcoming Regents exam.
Conspicuous	<i>Adj</i>	Noticable	The Star of David was conspicuous on all their coats.
Fatalist	<i>Noun</i>	One who believes that all events are determined by fate and can not be changed.	He felt there was nothing we could do to save ourselves; he was such a fatalist!
Inarticulate	<i>Adj</i>	Speechless or unable to express oneself.	I could not understand what she said, as she was inarticulate.
Indignant	<i>Adj</i>	Filled with anger over some meanness or injustice.	He was completely indignant because of the foul treatment he received!
Inferiority Complex	<i>Noun</i>	Tendency to belittle oneself	He felt he wasn't as good as the rest of us because of his inferiority complex.
Ineffectual	<i>Adv</i>	Without producing the desired effect	My efforts to cheer him up were ineffectual.
Insufferable	<i>Adj</i>	Unbearable	The treatment we received in the camps was insufferable.
Intuition	<i>Noun</i>	Ability to know immediately, without reasoning	Before I opened the door, my intuition told me I would regret it.
Mercurial	<i>Adj</i>	Quick or changeable in behavior	I couldn't ever figure him out. His moods were so mercurial.
Meticulous	<i>Adj</i>	Extremely careful about details	It was hard for a woman that was so meticulous in her appearance to wear the same dirty clothes day after day.
Ostentatiously	<i>Adv</i>	Showily	He waves the gun around ostentatiously just to scare us.
Ration	<i>Noun</i>	A fixed amount of a commodity officially allowed to each person during a time of shortage, as in wartime.	All of us were surviving on the ration for one person.
Sarcastic	<i>Adj</i>	Speaking with sharp mockery intended to hurt another	"Do you want to live?" The soldier asked us sarcastically, seeing as we had no control over whether we did or not.
Stealthily	<i>Adv</i>	In a sneaky or secretive manner	I stealthily hid beneath the bed in the secret place Papa made for us.
Unabashed	<i>Adj</i>	Unashamed	He proudly walked down the street, unabashed by the gold star sewn on his jacket.
