magazine cover assignment



Our first quarter theme in 10th grade English is **IDENTITY**. Throughout this class we will be talking about self-images, coming of age, and the quest to find oneself. As a preliminary exercise in exploring self-images, goals, and dreams, complete the following homework assignment:

Imagine you are the subject for the cover story of a magazine. What magazine would you be featured in? *Sports Illustrated, Newsweek, People, Rolling Stone, Vogue, Essence, Discovery, Ms.*? What would the headlines say about you?

Design the cover of the magazine as it would appear with your picture on it. You may use photographs, collage materials, computer graphics, etc., or you may draw it yourself. Represent yourself however you'd like to be known. Are you a great baseball player? An actress? A writer? A scientist? A musician? Will you win the Nobel Peace Prize? Cure AIDS? Put it in the headlines!

***Note: You may make the magazine a future issue if you choose... Tell us what you'll have done twenty years from now!

The cover you design must include:

- a title (*Newsweek, Vogue, People*, etc. or one you make up)
- your name in a headline, proclaiming what you've achieved
- a photograph or drawing of you

This assignment is worth three homework grades of \checkmark , $\checkmark+$, or $\checkmark-$ in the following areas:

Creativity	How original, unique, and thoughtful is your work?
Effort	Does the work show appropriate care and time?
Detail/Execution	Are the project requirements met? Are all components present?
