Criteria for admission:

Candidates must . . .

- Be currently enrolled in a TZHS Spanish course;
- Have completed two years of high school level Spanish;
- Maintain a minimum cumulative average of 90% in all Spanish courses;
- Hold a minimum grade point average of 85% in all high school courses;
- Demonstrate good citizenship, responsibility, and trustworthiness; and
- Participate in the official induction ceremony.

To maintain membership, members must:

- Volunteer as a tutor 2 periods per month;
- Actively participate in sponsored activities; and
- Attend meetings regularly.

Juniors and seniors currently taking Spanish at TZHS may be eligible for induction in La Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica, which is a national Spanish honor society, if the following requirements are met:

- You are currently taking Spanish .
- You have taken at least two years of high school Spanish with a minimum average of 90 or above in all Spanish courses at the high school. (Consideration of AP students' eligibility will reflect a 1.1 weighted grade.)
- You currently have a minimum cumulative average of 85.

The requirements to maintain membership include: tutoring, regular attendance at meetings, community service, participation in events, good citizenship and maintaining the minimum required for both Spanish average and overall cumulative average.
