... an acronym for the Management Achievement Program, offered by the College of Management.	... an online assessment offered to all undergraduate students each semester weeks 5-7 at UMass Boston.
... a requirement of all management majors.	... open to all UMass Boston degree-seeking undergraduate students.
... a way to quantify the ongoing professional development co-curricular requirement of management majors. Students must complete a certain number of MAP miles in order to register for the capstone class, MGT 490. 75% of the total MAP requirement must be completed to enroll in MGT 490. Students complete the remaining miles prior to graduation.	... a way to help you connect with your advisor and campus resources, and know yourself better. Answering the MAP-Works Assessment questions will create a personal report for you about how your behaviors and attitudes prepare you to meet your goals as a student at UMass Boston.
