- Overall G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher
- A major in Management, Finance, Accounting, or Economics
- U.S Citizenship or Permanent Resident of the U.S.
- Knowledge of MS Office applications and spreadsheet proficiency

- Good organizational skills and the ability to prioritize assignments under tight deadlines
- Attention to detail
- Ability to work as a team player
- Good interpersonal and communication skills in both verbal and written forms
- Ability to work 20 hours per week (2-6 PM Monday – Friday with possible flexibility) in addition to completing two UMass required classes per semester (6 credits)
- Ability to complete a 10 day period of full time training during the last two weeks of August 2014.
