This paper used relatively advanced econometric methods to complete a quasi-experimental analysis of data from the State of Florida in the 2000s. This paper rejects the findings of several prior academic works including those of the Coleman Report.

This Paper was written for Labor Economics and examined the ongoing impact that COVID-19 was having on small businesses across the nation. This paper specifically looked at how the CARES Act may have unfairly helped some small business owners more than others. The paper concluded that the impacts of the CARES Act were multi-faceted with some programs benefiting businesses in high-income states while other programs specifically benefited businesses in low-income states. We further conclude that such features were likely unintentional and may have been the result of rushed policy.
