(Table)</p> <p>Review Exploring Artism schedule. Ipad’s iBooks and hardcopy.(table)</p> <p>Warm-up: Today we going to look at the artwork of Henri Matisse. He uses different media/art supplies. Can any one guess what he uses?(Table)</p> <p>Color and draw your own shapes (worksheet.) (Table)</p>	<p>Schedule</p> <p>Talking Star Social Story Part I</p> <p>warm-up Worksheet with square/rectangles and Ipad for each child</p>	<p>Volunteer leads students up to 2nd floor via stairs; another via elevators</p>

<p>Pick a color and paint the cardboard background. (paint will dry while we look at Matisse works.)</p> <p>Ipad Activity: Moma Art Lab app –Drawing with Scissors (Volunteer passes out and collects ipads)</p> <p>Transition: Let’s go to our dots and look at the art and shapes that Matisse used.</p>	<p>Drop cloths,paint, and sponges brushes.</p> <p>Handout with tutorial</p>	<p>If there’s a lot of extra time, have kids paint paper sheets a different color.</p>
<p>Screen - Dots in front of screen</p>	<p>25 mins.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct students to sit on dots and pair with an adult. • Introduce life and cutouts of Henri Matisse. • Watch video of Matisse at work (youtube) • Show examples of Matisse’s cutouts. • Look at and describe what shapes we see in the painting. • What shapes do you see? Organic ?geometric? • What colors? How many? • How do you think the artist made this? <p>Look at Matisse’s Garden handout.</p> <p>Transition: Matisse believed he “painted with scissors” so now we are going to try to paint and draw with scissors.</p>	<p>Seating dots</p> <p>Matisse Youtube vid</p> <p>Matisse Ppt.</p> <p>Pass out Matisse’s Garden book images of him cutting.</p>	<p>Volunteers bring folders of shapes & dots down to DR.</p>
<p>Art-making Activity</p>	<p>25 Mins</p>	
<p>Volunteers help each participant with cutting and glueing: Pass out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5-10 different color sheets for each child. • scissors • templates to groups • cut-out pieces to each participant <p>Participants use glue stix to collage pieces/shapes together onto painted cardboard base.</p> <p>Each participant will make his/her own collage of shapes Volunteers help as needed</p>	<p>Pass out scissors</p> <p>Pass out glue sticks, paper shapes, and shape templates to each participant</p>	<p>Have scissors available to be passed out as needed.</p> <p>Have extra shapes and glue ready. Volunteers help kids cut/ glue/ place as needed.</p>
