- 2. Course modality (e.g., hyflex, hybrid, online/remote)
- 3. General student experience
- 4. Problem-solving or laboratory courses
- 5. Discussion-based courses
- 6. Team or group work
- 7. Questions about student participation
- 8. Overall qualitative feedback
