*New standards since mid-qtr 2 test:

- **Gilded Age-** Significant events of the Gilded Age including: political machines, major scandals, economic disparity, industrial capitalists, robber barrons
- **Child Labor-** Describe working conditions in factories
- **Samuel Gompers-** Analyze the role of Samuel Gompers and AFL (American Federation of Labor) in changing standards for working conditions
- **Inventors and Entrepreneurs-** Know the impact they had on society: Thomas Edison, Alexander Graham Bell, Henry Ford, George Eastman, George Washington Carver, Henry Bessemer, Swift and Armour, Cornelius Vanderbilt
- **Centennial Exposition-** Describe the Centennial Exposition of 1897 including its purpose, exhibits, and impact on the state.
- **Spanish American War-** Analyze the cause, course, and consequences of the Spanish American War including: Yellow Journalism, USS Maine, Rough Riders, Imperialism
- **Progressive Era-** Analyze the major goals, struggles and achievements of the Progressive Era, including attacking racial discrimination, child labor, big business, conservation, and alcohol use: Anti-Trust Laws; 16th, 17th, 18th, and 19th Amendments; immigration reform
- **Jim Crow Laws-** Describe the effects of the Jim Crow Laws on the nation and TN along with the efforts of Ida B. Wells and Randolph Miller to bring attention to the inequalities of segregation.
