WEEK ONE

WEEK TWO

Website Design Using Adobe Dreamweaver software, campers will learn the basics of website design including scripting and the use of graphics and animations.

Make-Up and Nails Taught in the BOCES professional salon, campers will learn the skills necessary to give a manicure and pedicure. They will also learn make-up techniques for both every day and formal application.

Robotics: The Importance of Design Principles Campers will work in teams to design different types of robots using the VEX Robotics Design System. Teams will compete in the CTEC Robotics Olympics on the last day of camp.

Intro to World Cuisine Campers will take a culinary journey around the world to learn the flavors and foods of cultural cuisine. Students will add to culinary and baking skills. They will show off their skills by inviting a guest to the Friday banquet.

I Can Fix It? Construction Maintenance 101 Campers will learn basic skills working on projects in the areas of carpentry, plumbing, electrical, painting, and other areas of the construction field based on campers' interests.

Who Done It? Intro to CSI Campers will learn how to investigate a crime scene as well as learn the basics of the criminal justice system. Techniques for fingerprinting and handcuffing will also be covered.

Automotive Maintenance Campers will work in BOCES' state-of-the-art automotive shop to learn the basics in automotive upkeep including oil change and tire rotation. They will also explore brake systems, and steering and suspension.

Exploring Vegetarian & Vegan Cuisine Campers will review meat substitutes, gluten-free, vegan and vegetarian options and create recipes based on the world's vegan and vegetarian cultures. They will show off their skills by inviting a guest to the Friday banquet.

The Science of Speed Campers will spend their week designing and building CO2-powered racecars – making them go fast! The week will end with our version of the Pinewood Derby, but on steroids!

Lunch: Campers will need to bring their own lunch, snacks, and drinks. They will be given a 20 minute break to eat and socialize.

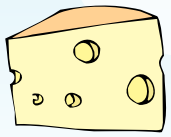
Transportation: Campers must provide their own transportation to and from camp.
