



Student Device Agreement

As part of tuition, students receive a 1:1 device to support their learning. This becomes the property of the student/family after two full years in attendance. If a student withdraws from the school before the two year period, they either return the device OR pay a residual to keep it.

The student agrees to follow SIS's Acceptable Use Policy which governs the use of the device as well as all applicable laws including copyright and intellectual property law pertaining to software and information.

The student shall not change the device's identification, such as it's name or IP address.

The student will not write on, nor put stickers directly on the device until it becomes the property of the student/family.

The student agrees to handle the device carefully and protect it from potential sources of damage. The student will assume the risk of loss by theft, destruction, or damage. If the device is damaged or returned with any accessories missing, SIS may charge the student for the cost of the repair or replacement cost if necessary.

The student must report theft or suspected theft of the device, loss of the device, damage to the device, or malfunctioning of the device to the Principal immediately.

Upon request, the student agrees to deliver the device to SIS staff for technical inspection, to verify inventory or to use for other school purposes.

I have read and agree to abide by all SIS policies and regulations for the use of equipment including the Acceptable Use Policy. I accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment while in my possession. I understand that, if the device or any accessory is lost, damaged or stolen, I am responsible for the replacement cost. I will report any damage to hardware or software immediately to the Principal.
