This can be done live or by recording a video (no longer than 3 minutes) with the QR code to the right and presenting it to your class. Use your answers on the back of this form to guide you.

**Step 5:** All shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by administrators and STUCO coordinators during the following week (September 10-September 14).
