Van Hentenryck	(ISYE 4134) By hiring faculty exactly like Pascal to teach other courses
Van Hentenryck	(ISYE 4134) I think some of the topics, particularly search, were of difficulty in applying and understanding at presentation - as they did not directly apply to an assignment for some time. This of course, is sensitive to when I watched the videos and likely my fault.
Van Hentenryck	(ISYE 4134) I would say my only criticism would be to ensure the entire class is following the conversation at hand. In our section a select few students were 1-2 weeks ahead of everyone else so I felt left behind when the instructor would simply direct attention towards them.
