Undergraduate Scholarships



The Consortium for Enabling Technologies & Innovation (ETI) is offering three undergraduate scholarships. The ETI's core mission is to direct the multidisciplinary research and innovation that enable the technologies to train the next generation of human capital, and to bridge the gap between the university basic research and NNSA national laboratories' mission-specific applications.

The ETI Scholarship recipients will receive up to **\$5,000 annually (for a maximum of two years)** toward the cost of their education, including tuition, books required for classes, housing expenses for on-campus facilities, off-campus room expenses with a valid rent receipt, and fees charged to students of similar academic standing. Scholarships will begin January 1, 2021.

Applications are due **November 1, 2020**.

Eligibility requirements:

- U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- GPA of 3.5 or above
- Enrolled as full-time undergraduate student at an accredited U.S. college or university

Applicants must submit:

- Personal study goals statement and how they relates to the ETI research (500 words max.)
- Two reference letters
- Official undergraduate transcripts
- Additional information (e.g., awards, publications/presentations, service work)
