- Congratulations to Richard Puscas on receiving the Affiliate Scholarship.
- We also nominated a Perimeter College student for the Wanda Garner presidential student Scholarship (under AMATYC).
- Sanda Manole reviewed the expenditures and revenues for the Treasurer's Report. The Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously by all attendees. The following changes were approved for next year:
  - Keep donating \$200 to the NGMT. (North GA math tournament)
  - O Change the donation for the Math League award from \$200 to \$100. (This is awarded to the student with highest score in the state of GA)
  - O Change donation for the hospitality room at the AMATYC conference from \$200 to \$100.
  - O Behnaz also suggested an increase in membership dues to \$15/year.
