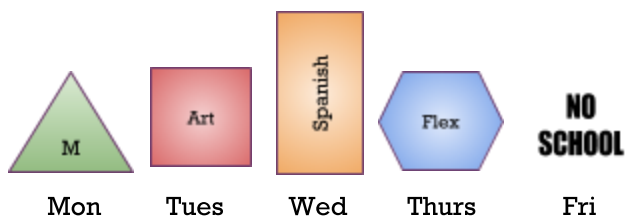
- Continue writing stories in Writing Workshop
