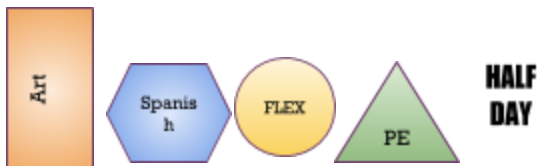

- **Currently enrolled Champions do not need to apply for enrollment. A letter of intent was sent home with all Champions on March 5th. Please submit your intent to return for next year.**
- **Siblings of enrolled students, who wish to attend IC Imagine next year, do need to submit an enrollment application. We encourage you to do this as soon as possible so as not to forget!**
