#### ELA

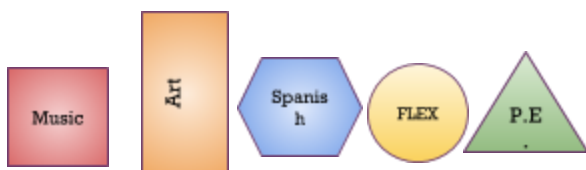
- Begin writing our small moment stories
