



LISD SHAC ACCOMPLISHMENTS THROUGH OUR ORGANIZATION AND OUR CAMPUSES

- 1. LISD kept health education as a graduation requirement for Lufkin High School students in all graduation plans when state government removed it as a requirement.**
- 2. LISD uses “Healthy and Wise/Spark” as the chosen Coordinated School Health Program for our elementary and middle school campuses.**
- 3. Developed a LISD “Food Allergy Protocol”.**
- 4. Developed the criteria for the district’s “Wellness Policy”.**
- 5. Review our campuses “Coordinated School Health Program” by using the CDC Health Index.**
- 6. SHAC recommends each campus develops a campus SHAC and send a representative to at least one district SHAC meeting to report on the campus SHAC activities regarding the 8 components of the CSHP.**
- 7. LISD staff mandatory online training of “7 Medical Emergency Modules”. These training modules are provided by our LISD nursing staff to instruct staff on how to handle medical emergencies at school.**
- 8. Development of a Drug, Alcohol and Violence Survey**
- 9. Staff Wellness programs in the form of flu shots, health screenings, weight loss and fitness programs.**
- 10. Developed three sub-committees for our SHAC:**
 - Sexual Health sub-committee**
 - Drug, Alcohol and Violence sub-committee**
 - Nutrition, Fitness and Safety sub-committee**
- 11. Implementation the Human Sexuality Abstinence Plus Curriculum: “Worth the Wait”-Lufkin Middle School and “Big Decisions”-Lufkin Middle School**
- 12. LISD developed a bullying report site called “SOS ~ Save Our Students”, for parents and students to report any bullying incidence.**
- 13. Lufkin Middle School added a new club to their campus, “No Place for Hate”. It is a national organization to help students with cultural awareness and promotes tolerance for different people groups. This program provides a voice for students that are bullied. It provides a place where they can meet and feel safe and learn to stick up for one another.**
- 14. SHAC recommends a daily mandated “early morning walk-through” of the Primary/Elementary playgrounds by the custodial staff, principal or PE staff to check for any potential hazardous issues such as trash or glass that could harm a student.**
