

2017 – 2018 Math Tutor Hall Goals and Guidelines

Goals:

- 1) To support MTHS students in gaining 3 mathematics credits for graduation.
- 2) To support MTHS students in remediating math deficiencies and deepening understandings with the emphasis on improving standardized test scores.

Guidelines:

- 1) Students must arrive to Math Tutor Hall on time and be prepared with materials and assignments.
- 2) Students must use Math Tutor Hall to work on mathematics as a first priority.
- 3) Students must be willing to work and ask questions, both on homework and supplementary materials. Since time is to be spent studying, there will be no sleeping or electronic device use. Hall passes will be limited.
- 4) **Students with below a 76.5% (a C) in their math course will be required to complete lessons on www.tenmarks.com or similar online program using Chromebooks/Netbooks. Progress on these lessons will be tracked.**
- 5) Students are expected to show respect to other students, peer tutors, and teachers.
- 6) Students are expected to comply with all MTHS handbook policies.
- 7) If this is their only study hall, students may use 15 minutes to work on other subjects.
- 8) Students will be given a Math Tutor Hall grade that will count as part of their regular math class grade.
- 9) Occasionally, placement in Math Tutor Hall will be re-evaluated.
