Einheiten 1&2 – present tense verbs using singular endings with singular personal pronouns, verb 2nd element, intro to modals *können* and *mögen*, the question words *wie*, *wo*, *woher*, *wer*, and *was*.

Einheit 3 – definite and indefinite articles, negations using *kein*, yes/no questions, use of *was*.

Einheit 4 – plural personal pronouns, plural nouns, plural verb endings, the question words *wann*, *wie viel*, *wie viele*.

Einheit 6 – accusative direct objects, definite and indefinite articles, and singular possessive adjectives in the accusative case

Einheit 7 – the two-way preposition *in* (in the accusative case), verbs with separable prefixes, negations using *nicht*

Einheit 8 – word order, irregular verbs, the comparative and superlative forms of *gern* and *gut*, the use of *welch*.

Einheit 9 – plural forms of the possessive adjectives, command forms

Einheit 12 – answering the question *wo* with the dative case

Einheit 13 – using *möchten* and *wollen*, directional vocabulary, dative case – 1st person singular and plural dative personal pronouns, indirect objects, answering the question *wo*

Einheit 14 – accusative personal pronouns, accusative reflexive pronouns, using an *s* to show possession with names, *immer*, *oft*, and words that show a sequence

Einheit 1 - personal pronouns in the dative case, verbs followed by the dative case (including *gefallen*), the subordinating conjunction *dass*

Einheit 2 – two-way prepositions (prepositions followed by the dative or accusative)

Einheit 3 – present perfect tense including regular and irregular verbs

Einheit 4 – the comparative form of adjectives and adverbs, simple past tense of modal verbs (*das Imperfekt*)

Einheit 6 – the superlative forms of adjectives and adverbs, the subordinating conjunction *weil*, the coordinating conjunction *aber*

Einheit 7 – adjective endings in the nominative and accusative cases

Einheit 8 – possessive adjectives in the dative case

Einheit 9 – the subordinate conjunction *wenn* and the conjunction *dann*, the verb *sollen*, review of the command forms
