

As we prepare to wrap up the current school year and look forward to the upcoming school year, please review the following items.

- Friday, May 15th will be the last new information and assignments coming out to your student. Until May 22nd, students will have time to finish up any assignments they need to complete. Even if their assignments are all complete, students should periodically check their school email and GoogleClassroom if teachers have questions. Grades will be posted on May 27th and students will have a survey to complete for each class to indicate if they want their letter grade or PASS. Teachers are only an email away during this time so please encourage your student to reach out with questions.
- As students finish up and turn in their last assignments the question has come up about the need to continue to fill out the attendance form on the school website.
  - Once students have completed all their learning activities, they are not required to turn in the attendance form on the school website.

#### Underclass Supply Pick-up/Drop-off

The guidance given by the state is that if students don't need it...leave it. With that being said, students will not be allowed in the building beyond the check-in area. If there is something essential they need from their personal locker, they should contact Assistant Principal Ron Kiesewetter ([rkiesewetter@mths.us](mailto:rkiesewetter@mths.us)) or Assistant Principal Kevin Hodel ([khodel@mths.us](mailto:khodel@mths.us)). Coaches have bagged the contents of athletic lockers and those will be available on pick-up day.

- We are requesting that only the student comes into the building.
- MTHS staff members have already gone through the lockers to pull out any items that are school property (textbooks, library books, etc.)
- Students who have textbooks, library books, calculators checked out from the library, uniforms and equipment, or any other school property at home should bring it with them on their scheduled date and time.
- Enter through the Madison Street entrance and proceed through the commons to drop off and pick up items. They will then exit out the wrestling room doors.
- There will be tables in the commons for textbooks, a table for library books, and one for Chromebooks (with power cord). Office staff will mark students off as they return their materials.
- Students should maintain social distance and take appropriate safety measures (utilize hand sanitizer, mask, handwashing, etc.) when dropping off and picking up materials.
