Begin by logging in to the [Quality Data Portal](https://qualitydata.alaha.org/) (<https://qualitydata.alaha.org/>) and from the home page select Maternal Hypertension Project.

Baseline column: If you see a Gray X, no baseline has been created. Simply click the Gray X and you can select any range for your baseline **summary** data. A **Red X** indicates that baseline data has not been entered. A **green checkmark** indicates the baseline has been created and data is complete. By clicking on either the **Red X** or **green check mark**, you can **edit or enter a baseline**.

Goal Entered column: If a goal has been entered, there will be a **green check mark** in this column. If a goal has not been entered, you will see a Gray X.

Data Entry column: The **Red X** indicates that a data is not up to date or has not been entered for all time periods. A **green checkmark** indicates that data is up to date.

TO ENTER A GOAL: Click on either to **add or edit your goal**. Your baseline will be available for reference on the Goal Entry Page.

1. **Select your start date** (use the dates suggested by the ALPQC).
2. **Enter your specific goal.** Note that you must enter a whole number in the field.
3. Specify whether that goal is a **specific rate, a decrease from the baseline or an increase from the baseline**. For example, you might have an internal goal for a 20% decrease. These goals can be for everyone participating in the project or you can hold your facility to a higher standard.
