
Who We Serve

- 3.057 average student-athlete G.P.A. highest in UD history
- 71% (15/21) of teams with a team G.P.A. over a 3.0 for the academic year
- 25 student-athletes had a 4.0 GPA
- 54 student-athletes recognized as members of the Chi Alpha Sigma
