**William Latham** is Director of the Center for Applied Business & Economic Research in the Lerner College of Business, Associate Professor of Economics and of Urban Affairs & Public Policy and CEEP Senior Policy Fellow at the University of Delaware. He served as chair of the Department of Economics from 1990 through 1996. He has been a visiting professor at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies in Seoul, Korea, at the University of Paris, at the University of Lyon, at the Hanken School of Economics in Helsinki and at Clemson University. Dr. Latham served on the first Governor's Economic and Financial Advisory Committee for the State of Delaware. He has also served on the City of Newark's Revenue Study Commission and the New Castle County Compensation Commission. He was a staff member to the Delaware Tomorrow Commission and the State's Intergovernmental Task Force. He has organized panels for national and international conferences and presented his research at conferences and universities across the U.S. and in many foreign countries. His research has been funded by a variety of state and national agencies including the U.S. Department of Labor.

Professor Latham received his B.A. and M.A. degrees for the University of Florida and his Ph.D. from the University of Delaware. Latham's books include ***The Economics of Persistent Innovation: An Evolutionary View*** and ***Locational Behavior in Manufacturing Industries***. He has published many research articles in the areas of impact analysis, regional modeling, economic development and innovation. They have appeared in such journals as *Journal of Energy and Development*, *Journal of Regional Sciences*, *Southern Economic Journal*, *Review of Regional Studies*, *Economics of Innovation and New Technology* and *Public Utilities Fortnightly*. Dr. Latham was Editor of *The Review of Regional Studies* and serves on the editorial board of the *Journal of Economic Research*. He has served as an outside reviewer for proposals submitted to funding organizations including the National Science Foundation and also as a reviewer of manuscripts for a number of professional journals.
