

2019-2020 Parking Permit Information

Vehicle Information Required for Permits

Please have your vehicle information available before purchasing a permit. Each permit can have up to 5 vehicles listed. Only one vehicle can be parked on campus per permit at a time. Students are not permitted to purchase parking for another student, including adding their vehicle onto an active permit. Parking permits starting Fall Semester can be purchased online as soon as the first business day of August.

e-Park Online Permit Requests

Please read the important information below before completing an e-Park request. Parking permits are virtual, the license plate of the vehicle is the parking credential. Please be aware of your parking eligibility before requesting a permit.

Explore Parking Categories

Online permit sales for upcoming terms begin on the following dates: Fall Semester permits are available online by the first business day in August.

- Fall in-person sales begin move-in weekend
- Permits are pro-rated on the 1st of each month.
- Winter Session permits should be purchased on or after January 1st to obtain the best price.
- Spring permits should be purchased on or after February 1st to obtain the best price.
- Summer permits should be purchased on or after June 1st to obtain the best price.

Review Permit Prices

Students wishing to bill their UDSIS account should process their parking request by August 15th for Fall Semester. Students living on-campus must know their residence hall assignment and it must be in the housing system before purchasing parking.

Eligibility

Anyone affiliated with the University who has a UDID and password may use this site to purchase a parking permit. Parking permit eligibility is based on information in your student/employee file for the term applying.

Metered Parking

Parking permits are not valid at parking meters unless accompanied by ADA parking privileges and a permit for the lot parked in. Meter activation is required at all times.

Visitors

Visitors can use this site to purchase short-term visitor passes. A guest log-in is required. Long-term visitor passes can be purchased in person with valid I.D. and registration or online, after contacting our office to verify the need for long term visitor parking. Visitors must purchase their own permits; students and staff are not eligible to obtain permits for visitors.

Permit Information Sheets

A parking permit signifies an individual has been granted the privilege of parking on University property. Ownership of the permit remains with the University of Delaware. Use of the parking permit is not transferable from the registered user.

The individual to whom a permit is registered is responsible for notifying the Parking Services Office within five days of any change in status, i.e., a commuter student moving on campus, resignation of a staff member who is then admitted as a University student, etc. If the change affects the eligibility of an individual to secure a parking permit, the Parking Services Office will determine the required modification and fee (if any). Multiple vehicles can be registered to one permit, but only one vehicle can be parked on campus at a time per permit.

Lot 83 Sorority Lot

Lot 83 permits are valid only in their assigned lot.

They are not valid anywhere else on campus at any time.

If you wish to park elsewhere on campus, you must purchase a permit, pay at meters or pay lots.

Annual Garage Permit

Annual Garage permit holders may park in other UD garages if space permits, Gray North, Gray East, Gray South or Red lots in addition to their assigned garage, with the following exceptions:

Trabant garage permits are not valid in lots 18, 19, 20, 67 Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.

Perkins garage permits are not valid in lots 50, 50S, 57 Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m.

This permit is also valid in non-restricted lots and the Pearson lot on weekends, holidays, and after 5 p.m. on weekdays.

Garage permit holders may not park in Central lots or Pearson lot, Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.

Carpool Permits

Enclosed is an informational sheet pertaining to your permit type and scratch off passes. Please be sure to read all information.

If both carpool members need to park on campus, the second vehicle should utilize a carpool scratch off pass. When using a scratch off pass, please be sure to scratch the appropriate month and date as they are considered used once scratched. Scratch offs should only be displayed on vehicles registered to the carpool.

Parking Services must be notified whenever an individual withdraws from a carpool to determine if the carpool membership has to be restructured to maintain eligibility.

If the carpool permit is cancelled, please return all unused carpool scratch off passes.

Gate carpool patrons: If you do not already have a gate access card, you will find one enclosed. Please use this card to enter (and exit in some cases) your assigned gate. Your individual ID card will not operate the gate arm. Scratch off passes are not valid in gate lots. No access card is used for Perkins garage or Center for the Arts Garage.

In an emergency, registered carpoolers can arrange for a guaranteed ride home through RideShare Delaware. For more information, visit the RideShare site, ridesharedelaware.org.
