HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 12

1 AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 12 by deleting “, combined with other actions,” as it appears on line 14.

2 FURTHER AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 12 by deleting “presented in the Plan of the Commission and” as
3 it appears on line 19.

4 FURTHER AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 12 by deleting “as presented in the Plan” as it appears on line 22.

5 FURTHER AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 12 by striking on lines 22 and 23 the language “as described in
6 the Plan and in the Redistricting Resolution contained therein” and substituting in lieu thereof the following “, however,
7 nothing herein shall obligate the General Assembly to any action with respect to financing, property reassessment, or
8 taxation”.

SYNOPSIS

This amendment clarifies that HJR 12 is not intended to commit the General Assembly to any action or agreement beyond confirmation of the State Board of Education’s approval of re-districting.
