

The Redding Consortium for Educational Equity Mandate Highlights

Senate Bill 148 & House Bill 222

From Senate Bill 148

The Consortium shall...

- **Develop and publish data reports** on the conditions impacting the educational outcomes of these students and also track the progress of these students
- **Spotlight best practices from across the state and nation** for increasing educational equity, improving educational outcomes
- **Facilitate collaboration** on implementation of best practices among school districts and charter schools
- **Evaluate the need for additional or alternative educational facilities** in the City of Wilmington including secondary schools
- **Develop policy proposals** to be introduced through legislation **to improve teaching and learning** in both district and charter schools in the City of Wilmington and northern New Castle County
- Research the viability of the **New Castle County Tax District and Tax Pool**

From House Bill 222

- **Develop a proposal for redistricting** in the City of Wilmington and northern New Castle County
- The Consortium's redistricting plan must be reviewed and acted upon by the State Board of Education **on or after January 1, 2021 and no later than April 1, 2021**
- The redistricting plan should take effect **on or after July 1, 2023 and no later than July 1, 2025**
