³Source for National Average is The College Board (www.collegeboard.org). The national combined SAT average is 1051 and represents the sum of the EBRW and Math national averages.

⁴The average "Total SAT EBRW and Math Scores" are calculated by first summing each student's highest scores on the EBRW and Math tests and then finding the average of this total score for all students.
