¹ Beginning in 2014, the methodology and results reflect National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) standards. The response rate is actually a "knowledge rate" which includes all available data collected. Results are unduplicated based on graduates' 1st Major.

² The number in class is based on expected graduates from IPEDS degree completions data.

³ The number of respondents includes baccalaureate respondents with valid data on Career Plans Survey question A, along with additional data collected toward the "knowledge rate".

⁴ Thirty-five (1.1%) of the 3,099 respondents indicated that they are participating in a volunteer or service program (e.g. Peace Corps), fourteen (0.5%) of the 3,099 respondents indicated they are engaged in military service, thirty-nine (1.3%) of the 3,099 respondents indicated that they are planning to continue education but are not yet enrolled, and six (0.2%) of the 3,099 respondents indicated they are not seeking work or further education in 2015.
