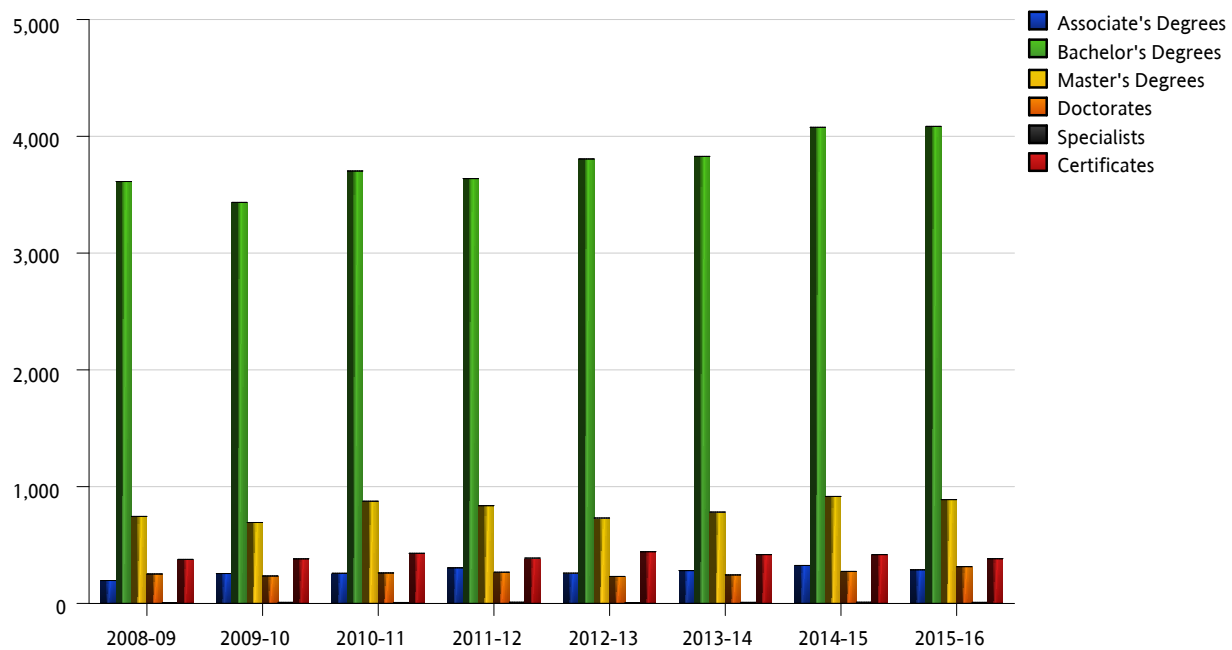

AS-BA, EG-BS), the sum of degree distinct totals may be greater than the number of students who graduated.
