ENTERING STUDENTS AND NEW BORROWERS

All entering students must complete a Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized Master Promissory Note (MPN) to borrow from the program for the 2021-2022 academic year. Please visit <https://studentaid.gov> to complete the Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized MPN.

When completing the Federal Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized MPN, you will notice that you do not have the option to enter a requested loan amount. The MPN is a serial note that is valid for ten years, and the borrower authorizes the school annually to increase the aggregate amount. Graduate students may borrow up to \$20,500 in Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan funds per academic year. RETURNING STUDENTS

The impact of this adjustment can be avoided by carefully budgeting your financial aid for the academic year.
