



Proof of Selective Service Registration

Based on a review of your financial aid application, you have been asked to provide proof of your registration with Selective Service.

If you are a male between the ages of 18 and 25 you must register for Selective Service. You can do so by visiting www.sss.gov. Please submit a copy of your proof of registration letter to financial aid services.

If you feel you are not required to register for Selective Service, please select your reason:

I was assigned the sex of female at birth

I am currently serving on active duty in the armed services. (This exemption does not apply to members of the Reserve and National Guard who are not on active duty)

I was not yet 18 at the time that I completed my FAFSA application (an update is not required during the year, **even if a student turns 18 after completing the application**)

I was born before 1960

I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia*

I am a noncitizen who first entered the U.S. after I turned 26

I am a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as lawful *nonimmigrant* on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after I turned 26

* A citizen or national of the Republic of the Marshall Islands or the Federated States of Micronesia who lives in the United States for more than one year for any reason except as a student or employee of the government of his homeland must register.

We will not be able to award any federal financial aid until we receive proof that you are registered with Selective Service or this signed form stating why you feel you are not required to register with Selective Service. **An official letter from the Selective Service System may be required before aid can be awarded.**
