Center for the Study of Race, Ethnicity & Equity Graduate Fellows Program

Each year, the Center for the Study of Race, Ethnicity & Equity will name as Graduate Fellows a select group of admitted students who are interested in the study of race/and or ethnicity, broadly defined. Graduate students in any terminal degree program are eligible. Fellows will be invited to share research or creative work in process with their cohort and Center Affiliates in both the Fall and Spring, to attend regular Center events, to take advantage of special professional development opportunities, and to propose future Center programming. Fellows will be eligible for \$1,000 annually to cover research- or conference-related travel or creative work. Active Fellows will be given special consideration for future Center-funded opportunities and programs. Based on a review of good-standing as Fellows and progress towards the degree, Fellows can renew their Fellowships for up to 5 years (for a total of 6 years of funding).

Each spring Deans of Graduate Education, Directors of Graduate Studies, or the equivalent can nominate up to two accepted graduate students per department, program, or school for the Fellowship. The Center will make a decision about each nominee within two weeks so that the Fellowship can be added to the school or departmental package. These are competitive fellowships, and the Center anticipates supporting a small cohort of up to five outstanding students from across the University who work on topics related to race and ethnicity, broadly defined.

The official offer letter from CRE² for admitted students who receive this Fellowship will include a paragraph outlining the Fellowship details.

Graduate admissions committees are urged to review the activities and programming organized by the Center at cre2.wustl.edu.

Nominations should include the applicant's cv, description or statement of research, and a letter of nomination highlighting the candidate's interest in the study of race and/or ethnicity, broadly defined. Nominations are due by February 1st, 2021 at 5pm and should be sent to cre2@wustl.edu.
