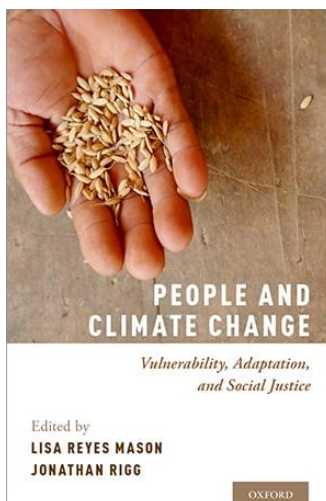
CSD leaders advise Taiwan's vice president on Child Development Accounts
