

Travel and Accommodations

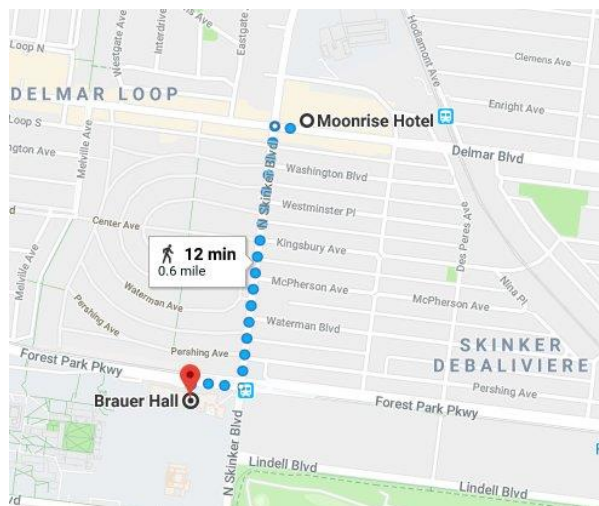
Airport. St. Louis Lambert International Airport (STL). The hotel is a short drive, or ride (by taxi or Uber), from the airport. One can also take the [MetroLink](#) if feeling adventurous. If you plan to see the sights in St. Louis during your stay, driving is recommended since public transportation is somewhat limited.

Lodging. Reservations have been made at the Moonrise Hotel for arrival on December 6th and departure on December 8th. The hotel has a guest list. You can call the hotel to confirm that you are on the list. If there is a discrepancy, please contact the symposium organizers at NEMS@wustl.edu.

Symposium Location. The symposium will be held in Brauer Hall (6220 Forest Park Parkway, Saint Louis, MO 63112) Room # 12, which is the auditorium in the center of the building on the basement level. Brauer Hall is approximately 1.0 km from the Moonrise Hotel, taking about 12 minutes by foot on Skinker Blvd (see map).



Symposium start/end time. The program will begin at 8:00 on Friday December 7th and end at 14:00 on Saturday December 8th.

Entertainment. The Delmar Loop, in which the hotel is situated, has many entertainment options including: restaurants, bars, music venues, shopping and a bowling alley.
