

Report on Faculty Trends 2012-13

Washington University Danforth Campus

This report looks at annual fall faculty counts for the Danforth Campus Schools, by gender and by ethnicity, over the last 15 years. The following table provides a summary of the population and trends covered in this report.

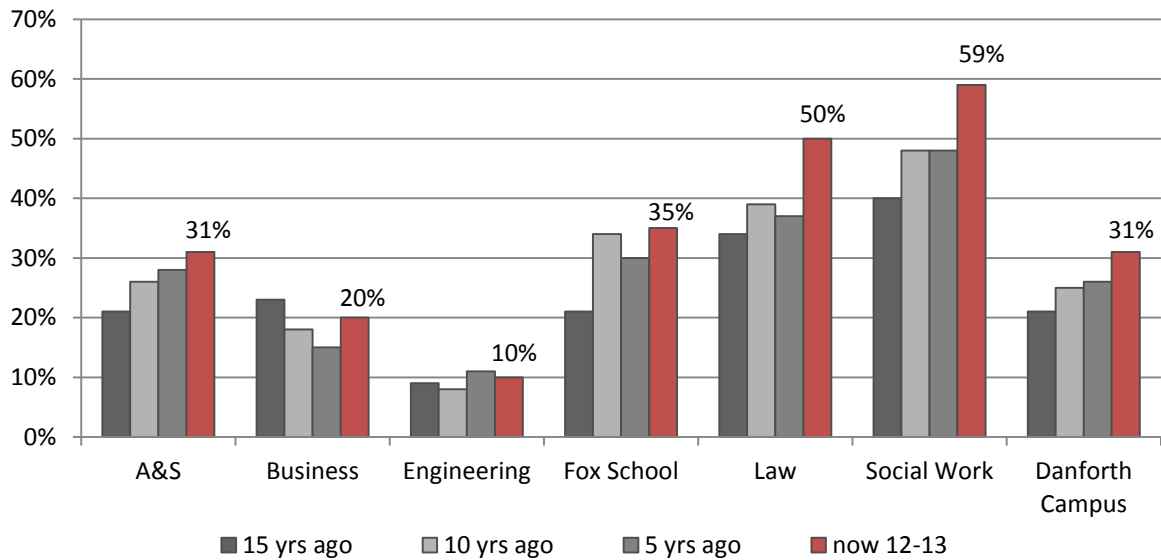
Over 15 years, the number of underrepresented minority tenured and tenure track faculty grew by 73% (from 26 to 45) while the overall tenured and tenure track faculty total grew by 20%. The number of women increased by 73% (from 118 to 204) while the number of men grew by 5% (from 436 to 459) over the same period.

This report begins with some summary graphs showing how the percentages of women and URM faculty have changed over time for each school and for the Danforth Campus overall. Detail tables for each school and for the consolidated Danforth Campus follow.

This report focuses primarily on tenured and tenure track faculty, but the detail tables also include trend and diversity information for non-tenure track faculty.

The data are based on the University's annual fall faculty counts as of November 1 each year. This collection of faculty data was established in 1993 by a working committee of the deans of the Danforth Campus Schools to provide a consistent way of counting faculty across time.

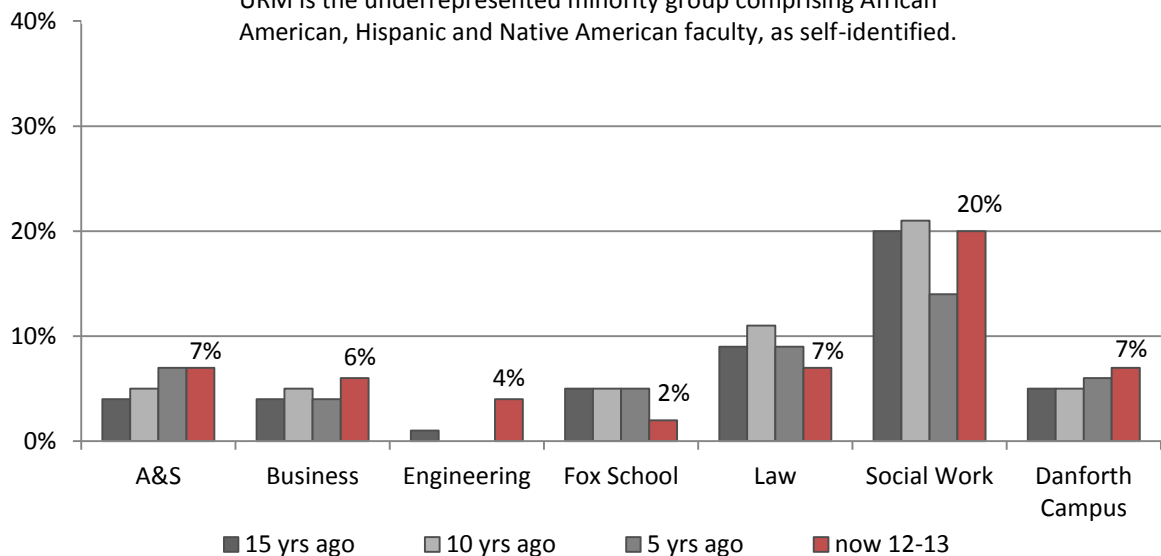
Danforth Campus Trends Women as % of Tenured & Tenure Track Faculty



The percentage of tenured and tenure track faculty who are women has grown over the last 15 years. Women now represent 31% of tenured and tenure track faculty on the Danforth Campus. The schools of Law and Social Work have the highest percentage of women with 50% and 59% respectively.

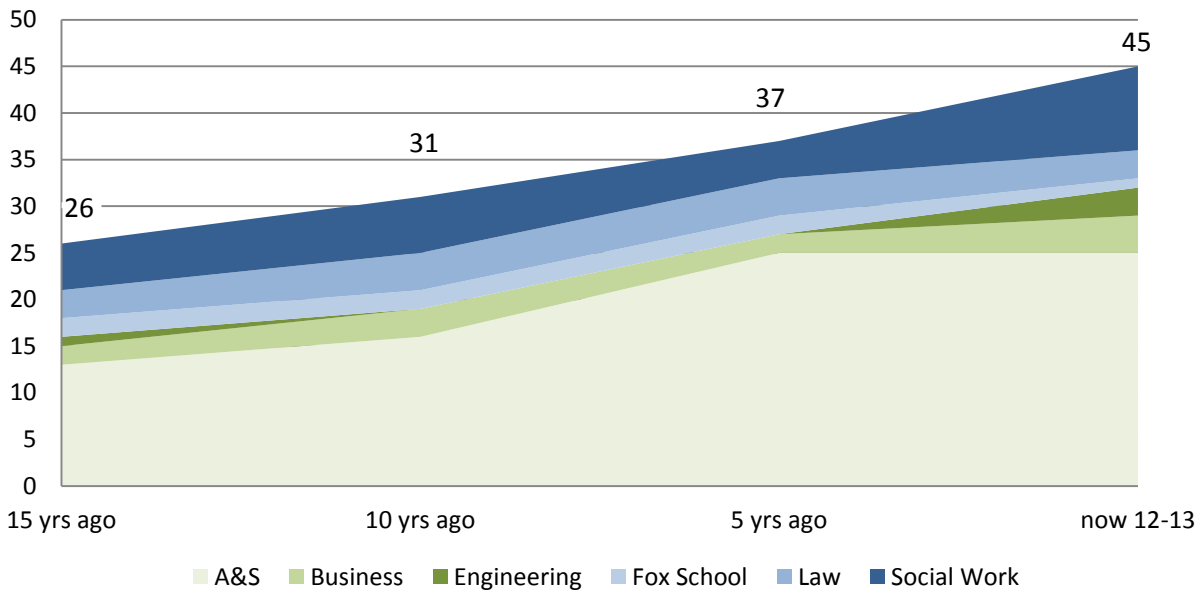
Danforth Campus Trends URM as % of Tenured & Tenure Track Faculty

URM is the underrepresented minority group comprising African American, Hispanic and Native American faculty, as self-identified.



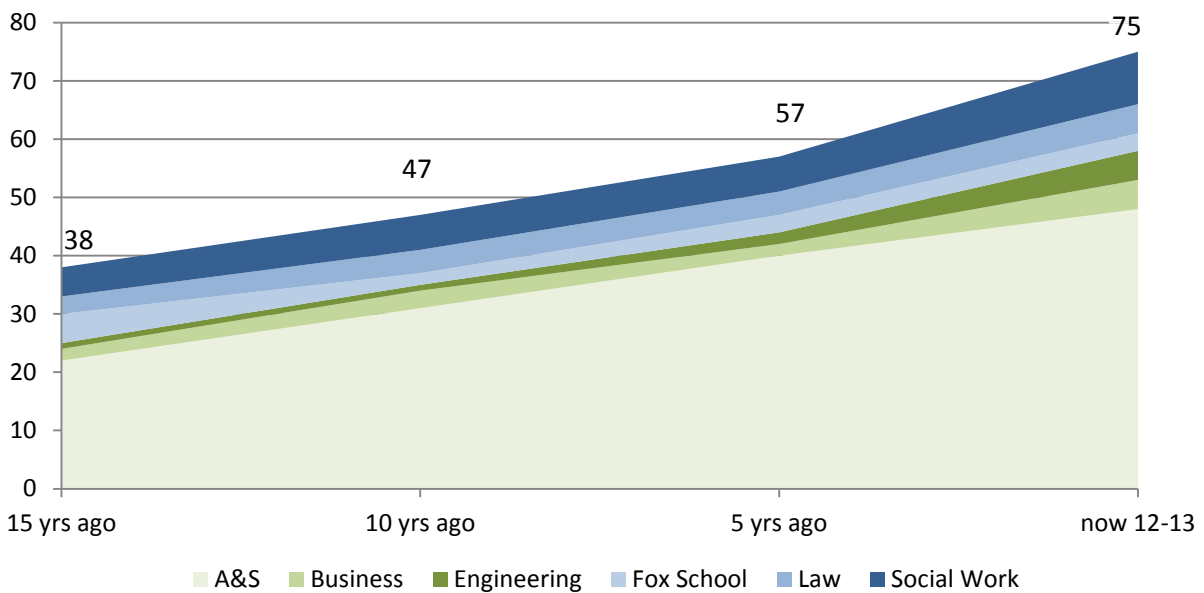
URM as a percentage of tenured and tenure track faculty has increased from 5% to 7% on the Danforth Campus over the last 15 years. Social Work is highest at 20%. The numbers are small in all Danforth schools and progress has been slow.

The number of tenured and tenure track underrepresented minority faculty has grown by 73% over the past 15 years, from 26 to 45.

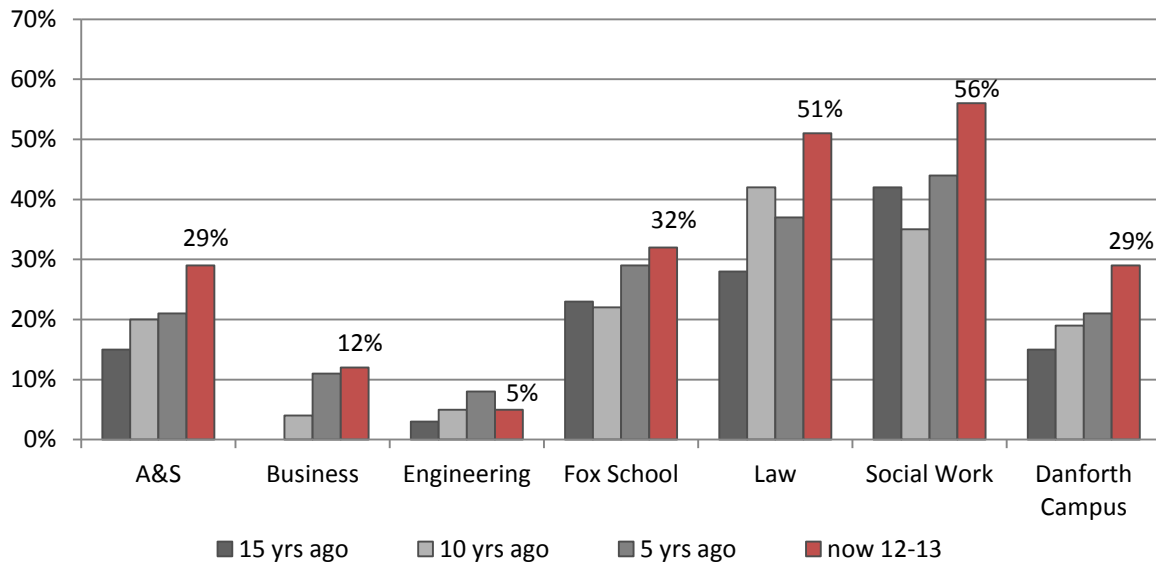
Danforth Campus Trends URM Faculty Counts, Full Time



The number of full-time underrepresented minority faculty overall has grown by 97% over the past 15 years, from 38 to 75.

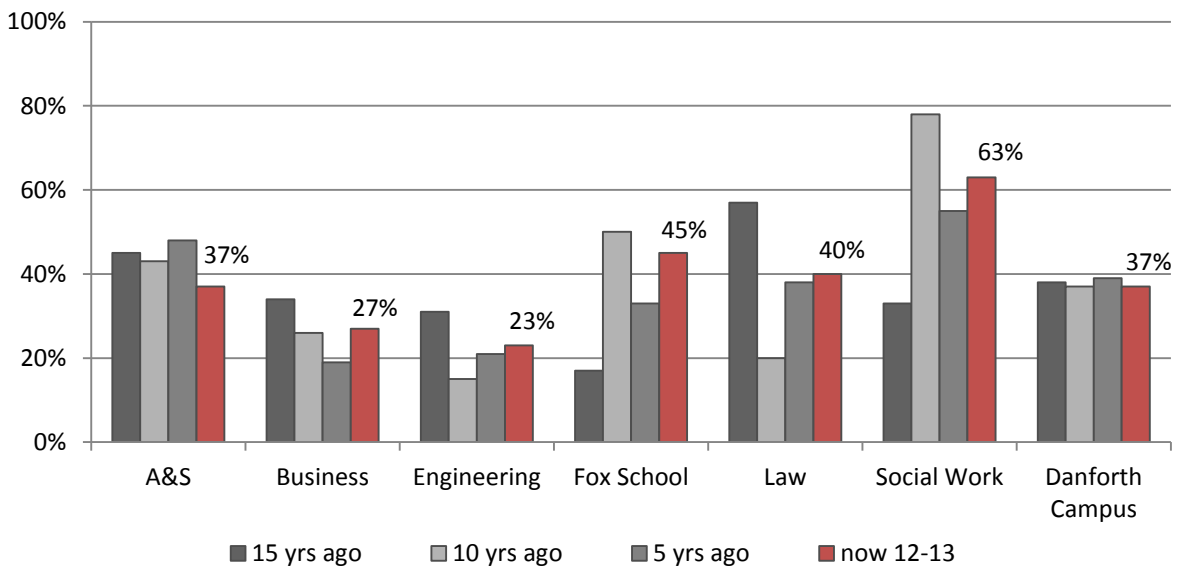

Danforth Campus Trends Women as % of Tenured Faculty



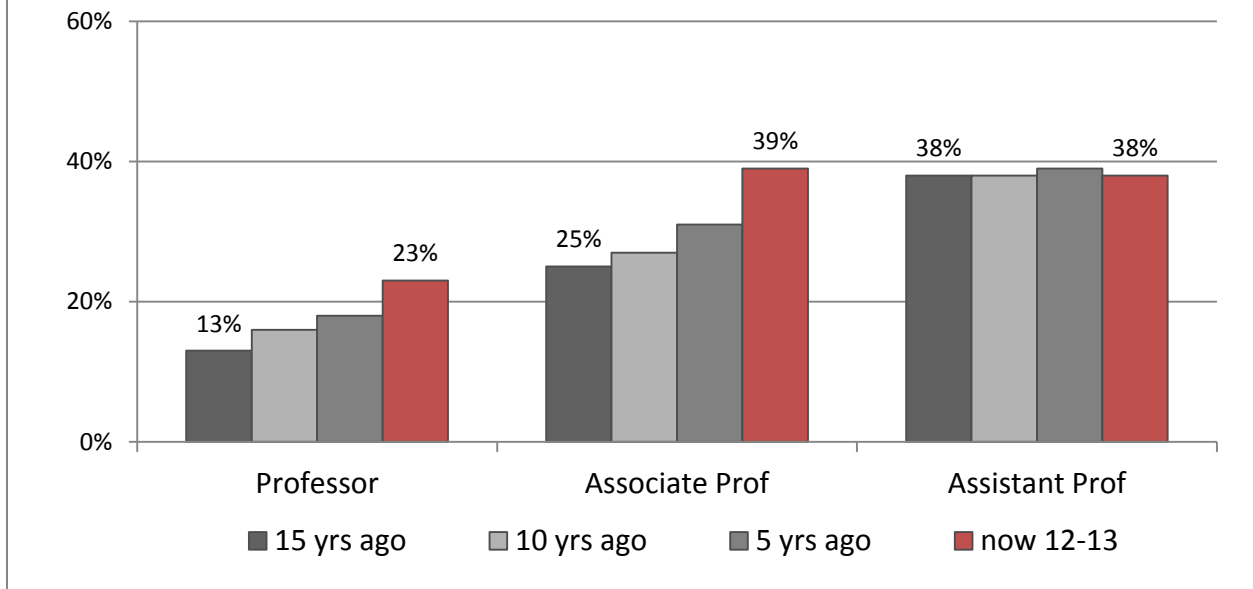
The percentage of tenured women faculty has grown in each of the Danforth Schools over the last 15 years. Women now represent 29% of tenured faculty on the Danforth Campus. Law and Social Work have the highest percentage of women at 51% and 56% respectively. Engineering is the lowest at 5%.

Danforth Campus Trends Women as % of Tenure Track Faculty



Women now represent 37% of tenure track faculty on the Danforth Campus. The percentage of tenure track faculty who are women is 37% or higher for four of the six Danforth Schools.

Danforth Campus Trends Women as % of Rank



The percentage of women holding the rank of full professor has increased from 13% to 23% over the last 15 years. Women now represent 38% of Assistant Professors and 39% of Associate Professors. If one assumes equal promotion rates for men and women, women's percentage of the full professor rank should continue to rise to match the assistant professor entry rate.
