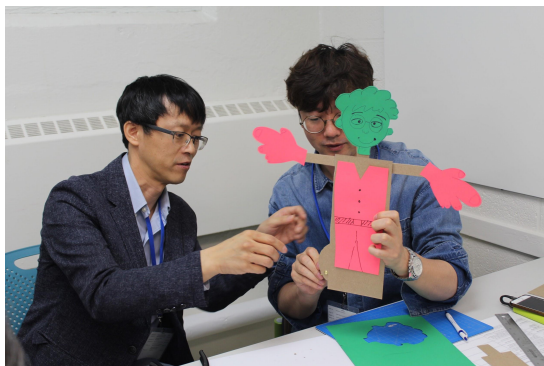
Novel Engineering Conference June 13 and 14, 2019
